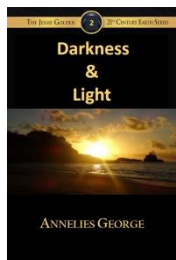


The Jessie Golden series & Quantum Physics

In the *Jessie Golden 21st Century Earth Series*, Dutch journalist Jessie Golden is trying to unravel her life destiny and her journey into the unknown. The story is closely related to today's reality and the author's fantasy of what could happen if we let things run their own course. *Quest to the Unknown (part one)* was recently published and introduces the main characters of the series. Step by step the author elaborates more on (sensitive) topics, which she cleverly entwined in the fiction story.

When writing the second part in the Jessie Golden series, *Darkness & Light*, available in 2018, Dutch author Annelies George reflected on something she had written based on her findings. Are we still able to turn this destructive trend around before the Earth decides to take its own measures to restore balance in an act of purification of the planet?

Those are fine words, Jessie thought, putting the notes aside for a second. A dramatic change would be required to turn this trend around. Basically she very well understood the message Nancy was trying to convey.

You're affected by the actions and words of others, acting accordingly just like the quantum physics principle of the interdependency of connecting parts.

Science did confirm particles have a lasting effect on each other, even though these particles were physically no longer together after the initial encounter. Once a critical mass had been achieved, this eventually would snowball--exactly what Nancy had reflected in her speech. As a consequence terrorist groups were sprouting up over the past decades, with all that implied.

It's not half as complicated as it looks. Open your eyes, your nose, your mouth and your ears. See what appears to be invisible so far, smell the trail to the path leading to peace, speak the language coming from your heart and listen and answer the call for love. Only then will our lives be enlightened by the light of love.
